The Prince George Potters' Guild is pleased to present a workshop with Huang Fei from Jingdezhen, China. The hands-on workshop will demonstrate Chinese blue-on-white painting on porcelain, provide information on the use and handling of Chinese brushes, and include discussions on identifying ceramics through the range of dynasties. This workshop will be held in three-hour sessions once a week for four weeks (6:30pm - 9:30pm). This will allow participants to fire their pieces between sessions, to see their finished work, and allow for critiques.

Huang Fei had a chance meeting with Walter Ostrom when he was a young man. The meeting changed his perspective and his way of thinking about life and art. Huang Fei's tenacity, perseverance and work ethic has led him to be a very successful artist in Chinese blue-on-white painting on porcelain and landscape painting. His engaging teaching style in the art of Qing Hua is a fascinating way to share Chinese history through cobalt painting.

The workshop fees is \$200 and includes:

- Slide presentation: November 7, 2014 at 7pm in the Jack Bryant Room
- four three-hour sessions 6:30pm 9:30pm
- 1 box of pure-white porcelain
- 2 Chinese brushes
- bisque and glaze firing for 10 pieces.
